

Meriwether Lewis and William Clark opened a great age of American exploration from 1804 to 1806 when they set out to map the 1803 Louisiana Purchase. Over 200 years later, you can re-create the Corps of Discovery's sense of awe and wonder by "*Doin' the Louisiana Purchase*". The program is easy to follow: simply walk one walk, *any* walk, in each of the 15 states included in whole or in part by the Louisiana Purchase. Those states would be: Louisiana (naturally!), Texas, Arkansas, Oklahoma, New Mexico, Missouri, Kansas, Colorado, Iowa, Nebraska, Wyoming, Minnesota, North Dakota, South Dakota and Montana. You've got 5 years to finish the program – and you're allowed to travel by car, bus, train or plane, unlike the original Lewis and Clark Expedition!
