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## **NEC Committee News**

## Special Programs 2017 – Bonnie Johnson, Chair, Special Programs Committee

On Jan 22 2016, the NEC approved the revised AVA Special Programs Management with a starting date of Feb 1, 2016; and directed that it be moved into the Policy Manual. Highlights of the revised AVA Special Programs Management include:

1. The NEC established a goal of 12 active Special Programs per year. The current large number of Special Programs will be downsized through attrition. AVA is now projected to be at or below its goal in 2020.

2. For 2017 and 2018, the NEC limited itself to approving no more than 2 additional Special Programs per year.

3. The NEC will use the following 6 criteria to evaluate potential Special Programs:

- A. Historical Significance: Will the Volkssporter learn about events of historical significance or cultural interest?
- B. Scenic Interest: Will the Volkssporter visit sites of scenic interest or significant natural beauty?
- C. <u>Geographic Area</u>: Will the Special Program be relevant in all or most of the United States?
- D.<u>Qualifying Events</u>: Are the qualifiers clearly described and easily understandable? Will it be easy to determine which walks qualify?
- E. Award Appearance: Is the Award attractive?
- F. Entertainment Value: Will the Special Program be fun?

4. Since the Special Programs will be limited to 12 per year, no club or individual may have more than one Special Program approved at a time.


5. The revision also includes the ability for the NEC to reactivate an old Special Program, and lays out the conditions under which this could occur (it must have been 10 years since it ended and it must have sold at least 150 books).

6. The NEC directed the National Programs Chair (SWRD Susan Medlin) to create a new National Program with more challenging events of distance or difficulty. All proposed Special Programs to be considered for approval

at the January 2017 NEC meeting must be sent to your Regional Director and to Bonnie Johnson, Special Program Chair, for review.

7. The NEC approved the following 2 new Special Programs in 2016 which will begin January 1, 2017.





# Strategic Planning Update – David Bonewitz, Chair, Strategic Planning Committee

## STRATEGIC PLANNING – The Roadmap Begins to Take Shape

At its January meeting in Las Vegas, the National Executive Council heard the report from the Strategic Planning Committee (SPC). For over 3 hours on January 22<sup>nd</sup>, the NEC heard a high-level review of the



recommendations of the SPC; then on the 23<sup>rd</sup>, the NEC worked through the details and edited the Courses of Action. Some agreed actions were immediately assigned to Standing and Ad hoc committees to begin fleshing out the plan. Other parts will need further study and review.

Given the amount of work done, it will take a bit of time to review the results and ensure that everyone is on the same sheet of music. So, it would be premature to put a lot of detail here. However, it is important that you recognize that we are moving forward. In the area of Mission Achievement, we are looking at mechanisms to grow our membership, improve our member programs, and establish a program to enhance club development. In Financial Sustainability, we are looking at developing donors and sponsors, increasing grants, and meeting standard nonprofit financial ratios. In the area of Operational Efficiency, we are focused on a national publicity strategy, member-centered data management, and a review of operational costs. In Governance and Leadership, we are looking at restructuring the NEC committee structure and meetings to enhance our strategic capacity and editing the Bylaws to move operational details into the Policy Manual. All of this and more is just in the first phase from now to December 2017. With two more phases in the following years, there is much more to come.

So, stay tuned. Lots of details will soon be available. If you weren't already, it is certainly time to get excited about the bright future of AVA.
